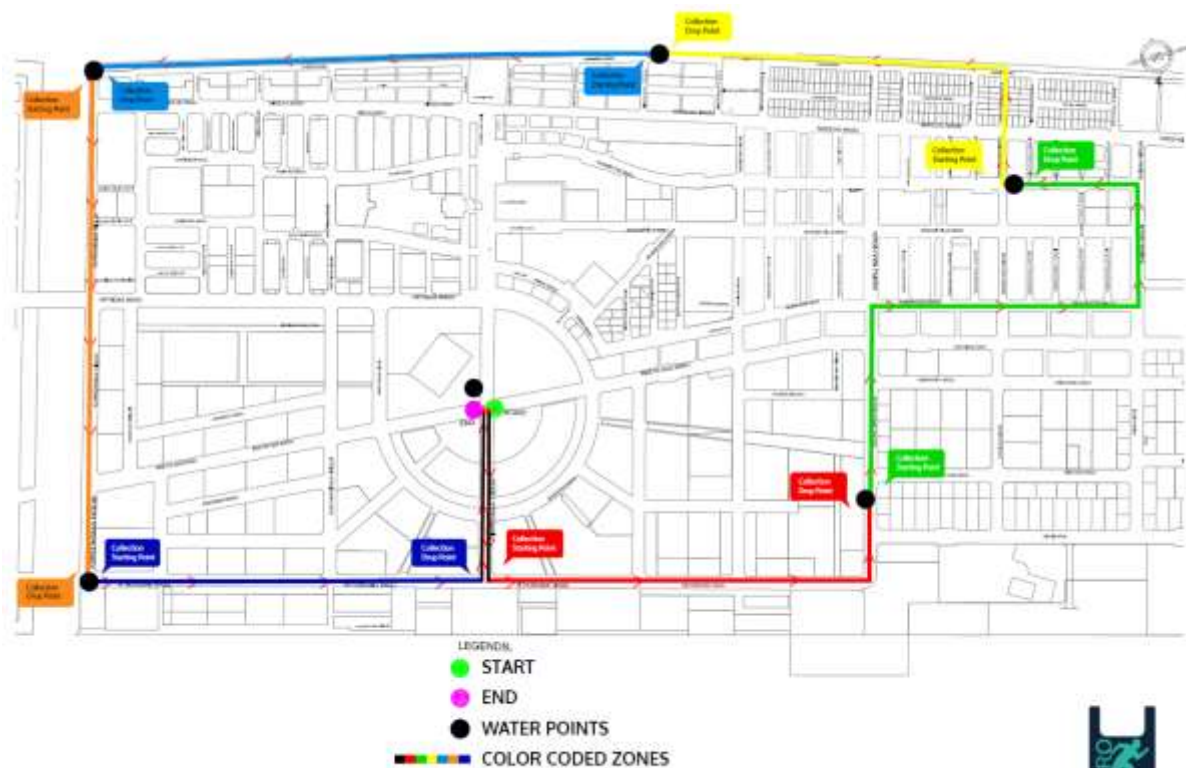

## Event Program

<b>7:30am</b>	<b>Arrival of event participants.</b> Handover the clean plastics brought from home to the Main Plastics Collection Desk.  Pick colour coded bag from the Bags Distribution Desk. This is to collect plastics from the colour coded zones on the run/walk route.	Hulhumale' Central Park
<b>7:45am</b>	<b>Proceed to line up behind the Run/Walk Starting Point.</b> Representatives from participating NGOs will be speaking about our cause: to stop using single-use plastics.	Starting Point
<b>8:00am</b>	<b>Zero Plastic Run/Walk will begin sharp at 8:00am with count down and start whistle.</b>	Starting Point
<b>9:45am</b>	<b>All participants completing the course and crossing the Finish Line will be awarded an eco-friendly medal.</b>  Participants are requested to return the colour coded collection bags to the Bags Distribution Desk or to the Collection Points on the route.  Participants are invited to pledge by palm-printing on a special banner at the designated area, to support the cause of Zero Plastic Run: to eliminate use of single-use plastics.	Finish Line

### Important Information

- Zero Plastic Run is not a race. It is a run / walk which is not timed and emphasis is placed on completing the event and making a stand for the cause of the event.
- All participants are advised to bring clean single-use plastics waste to the event as much as possible. Our partners will be establishing plastic collection points at different areas of the event venue where all the plastics will be gathered and it will be taken for recycling by Parley.
- If participants want to bring their own water bottles, please bring in reusable bottles or containers. The entire event will be carried out without the use of harmful single-use plastics.
- Participants are encouraged to collect plastics that they may come across along the course path, and deliver to the collection stations. To facilitate this the run/walk course path is divided into six zones with each zone assigned a colour as shown in the route map. Special colour coded bags provided by Parley can be collected from the event grounds prior to starting the run/walk.
- You can carry the plastics to the colour coded collection stations placed at the beginning and end of each zone. Members from the Endorsing NGOs will be there throughout the route to guide. Please return the bags to the collection station prior to leaving the event grounds.
- There will be five (single-use plastic free) water points along the route. Stay hydrated.
- First Aid services will be available during the event and ambulance services will also be available in case of an emergency.
